Who We Are In Christ

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. (*He created us and sustains us in a walk prepared and planned before we were born*).

1 Peter 1:23

having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,

2 Peter 1:4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust. (*His nature is our nature*).

1 Peter 2:9 But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; (*We have been specially selected and belong to royalty*).

Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, (*We belong to His family*).

Colossians 1:13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love, (*He personally removed us from the authority of sin and darkness and set us in Jesus' Kingdom*).

Romans 6:6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with *Him*, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. (*We are not who we used to be. Our old self was destroyed when Christ died*).

Galatians 3:29 And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. (*Everything He has is ours*).

Romans 12:11-12 not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;

Romans 12:1-2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
